Women with high-risk pregnancies must be treated by real medical professionals. **But treatment should not include intentionally killing a child.** (if a child dies during the course of treating the worman i.e. during chemotherapy for cancer, removal of an ectopic pregnancy, etc this is not abortion).

The trauma and pain associated with an abortion experience may produce farreaching effects that, if left unattended, may lead to what is now being recognised as Port Abortion Syndrome. Refer to open doors link below.
