

I am submitting to this panel about why the bill should be dropped, liked the previous. As you undoubtedly remember from the previous submissions, an aborted child IS a case of murder. So whether it is at birth or 24 weeks or even earlier, it is still murder.

One thing of immense importance is that women must be offered, first, the option of adoption. There are so many people looking for children that it is a crime to deny them the blessing of these children.

The judgement of God comes on a people when they refuse to abide by His Commands. He is merciful and waits to see if they will repent or not, but ultimately He will judge them.

The blood of any aborted child will ultimately be paid for by the shedding of blood. If you doubt this consider Jesus' statement: Mt 23:35 **That upon you may come all the righteous blood shed upon the earth, from the blood of righteous Abel unto the blood of Zachariah son of Barachiah, whom ye slew between the temple and the altar.**

So this happens in 70 A.D. with the destruction of Jerusalem. And Jesus says in the book of Revelation that blood will again be required of the world. **Re 18:24** And in her [Babylon] was found the blood of prophets, and of saints, and of **all** that were slain upon the earth.

Re 19:2 For **true and righteous [are] his judgements**: for he hath judged the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and hath **avenged** the blood of his servants at her hand.

People forget that Jesus is not just Saviour but Judge, and that He will judge the earth and the heavens. So I petition you for your own sake and that of the state, to reject this bill for the reason of blood guilt, alone. I know of several cases where people died because of their sin and the shedding of innocent blood – which is one understanding for the blood of unborn children.

Then there is the fact that it is NOT in accordance with the Law of God and as such is not truth but a lie. There is ABSOLUTE TRUTH, and the level to which we **humbly** seek God in obedience is the level to which we can correctly know the Truth. Our worldly based mindsets can be renewed to this Truth by the Word of God – as it is written.

He is merciful to our ignorance but still expects us to seek Him out and keep His commandments – even if we don't understand them.

This is why Truth IS Light and what is not of Truth is darkness, the absence of Light. Consider **Isaiah 8:20** **To the law and to the testimony: if they speak not according to this word, it is because there is no light in them.** So Jesus says: Mt 6:23 **But if thine eye be evil, thy whole body shall be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in thee be darkness, how great [is] that darkness!**

So be careful that what you think is light is, in fact, darkness and not Light at all! Judge it by the Law of God, not man's. There is many other things I could say regarding this but this is enough of theology.

The unborn child is NOT part of it's mother. It is attached and get's it nourishment from her BUT is not her. It is it's own being sent from God. In fact, the child is already alive long before it looks human in the womb. IT CAN **ONLY** BECOME A HUMAN: nothing else. The child hears and feels everything that is going on around it – proven medical fact. As I am sure the previous

submissions to the other bill in this area told you.

So you will never know who this child would have been if you kill it; yet alone sell it for body parts like Planned Parenthood does.

As a follow up to what I have said I have supplied the following Psalm. Think about it carefully; especially the verse where it talks about “frameth mischief by a law.” For that is exactly what this bill seeks to do. The judgement written is severe.

Ps 94:1 ¶KJ. O LORD God, to whom vengeance belongeth; O God, to whom vengeance belongeth, shew thyself.

2 Lift up thyself, thou judge of the earth: render a reward to the proud.

3 LORD, how long shall the wicked, how long shall the wicked triumph?

4 How long shall they utter and speak hard things? and all the workers of iniquity boast themselves?

5 They break in pieces thy people, O LORD, and afflict thine heritage.

6 They slay the widow and the stranger, and murder the fatherless.

7 Yet they say, The LORD shall not see, neither shall the God of Jacob regard it.

8 Understand, ye brutish among the people: and ye fools, when will ye be wise?

9 He that planted the ear, shall he not hear? he that formed the eye, shall he not see?

10 He that chastiseth the heathen, shall not he correct? he that teacheth man knowledge, shall not he know?

11 The LORD knoweth the thoughts of man, that they are vanity.

12 ¶ **Blessed** is the man whom thou chastenest, O LORD, **and teachest him out of thy law;**

13 That thou mayest give him rest from the days of adversity, until the pit be digged for the wicked.

14 For the LORD will not cast off his people, neither will he forsake his inheritance.

15 But judgment shall return unto righteousness: and all the upright in heart shall follow it.

16 Who will rise up for me against the evildoers? or who will stand up for me against the workers of iniquity?

17 Unless the LORD had been my help, my soul had almost dwelt in silence.

18 When I said, My foot slippeth; thy mercy, O LORD, held me up.

19 In the multitude of my thoughts within me thy comforts delight my soul.

20 Shall the throne of iniquity have fellowship with thee, **which frameth mischief by a law?**

21 They gather themselves together against the soul of the righteous, and condemn the innocent blood.

22 But the LORD is my defence; and my God is the rock of my refuge.

23 **And he shall bring upon them their own iniquity, and shall cut them off** in their own wickedness; yea, the LORD our God shall cut them off.
