Dear MPs

I urge Queensland parliamentarians to NOT support this abortion bill. Aside from the safety and well being of my own family, I consider the safety of other persons In Queensland the very highest priority for myself and our government.

I strongly believe there is insufficient scientific basis to conclude that an unborn foetus is not yet a living human. The law should, wherever possible, protect the unborn foetus as a legal person as the default position until the science can determine at what point in time a foetus can be concluded a living (though unborn) human.

It is my belief that the true sign of civilisation is the degree to which the powerful protect and look out for the basic well being of the powerless. Likewise it should be assumed civilised politicians would (by default) be a voice for the voiceless.

The proposed bill would allow lawful killing of powerless and voiceless persons in Queensland.

I urge you to be that voice for these voiceless unborn children, and exercise your power to withhold harm from these children.
