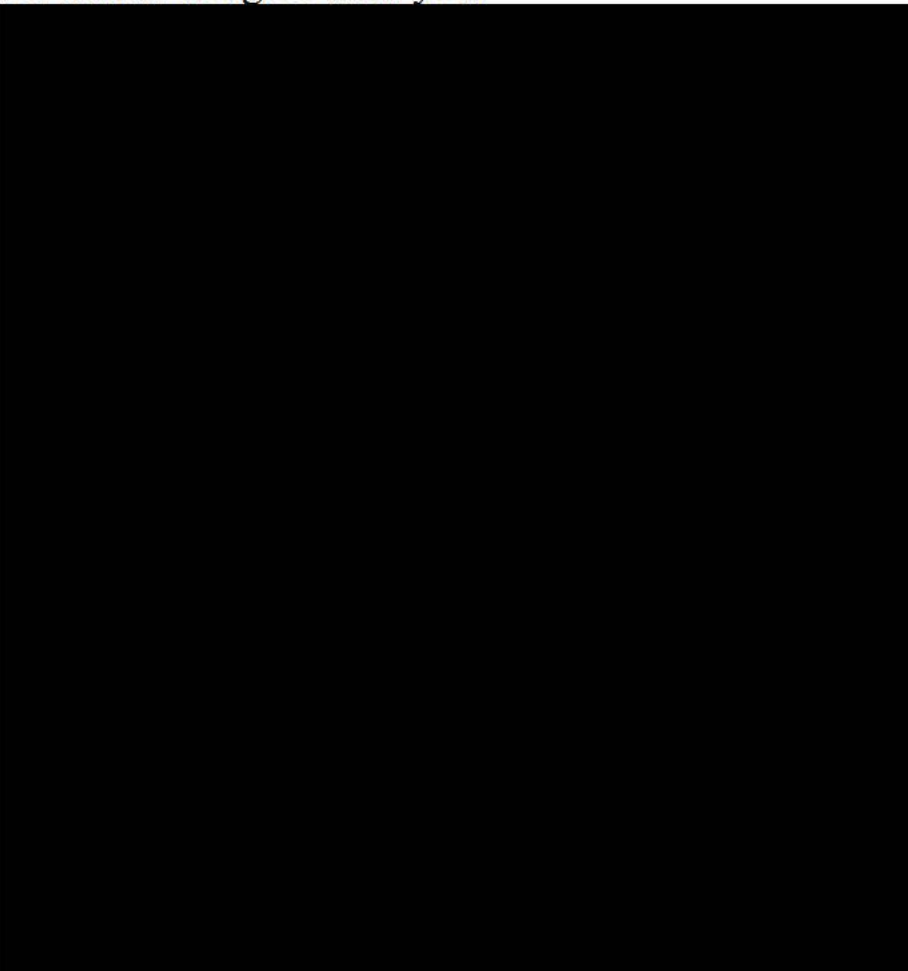
Dear Sirs,

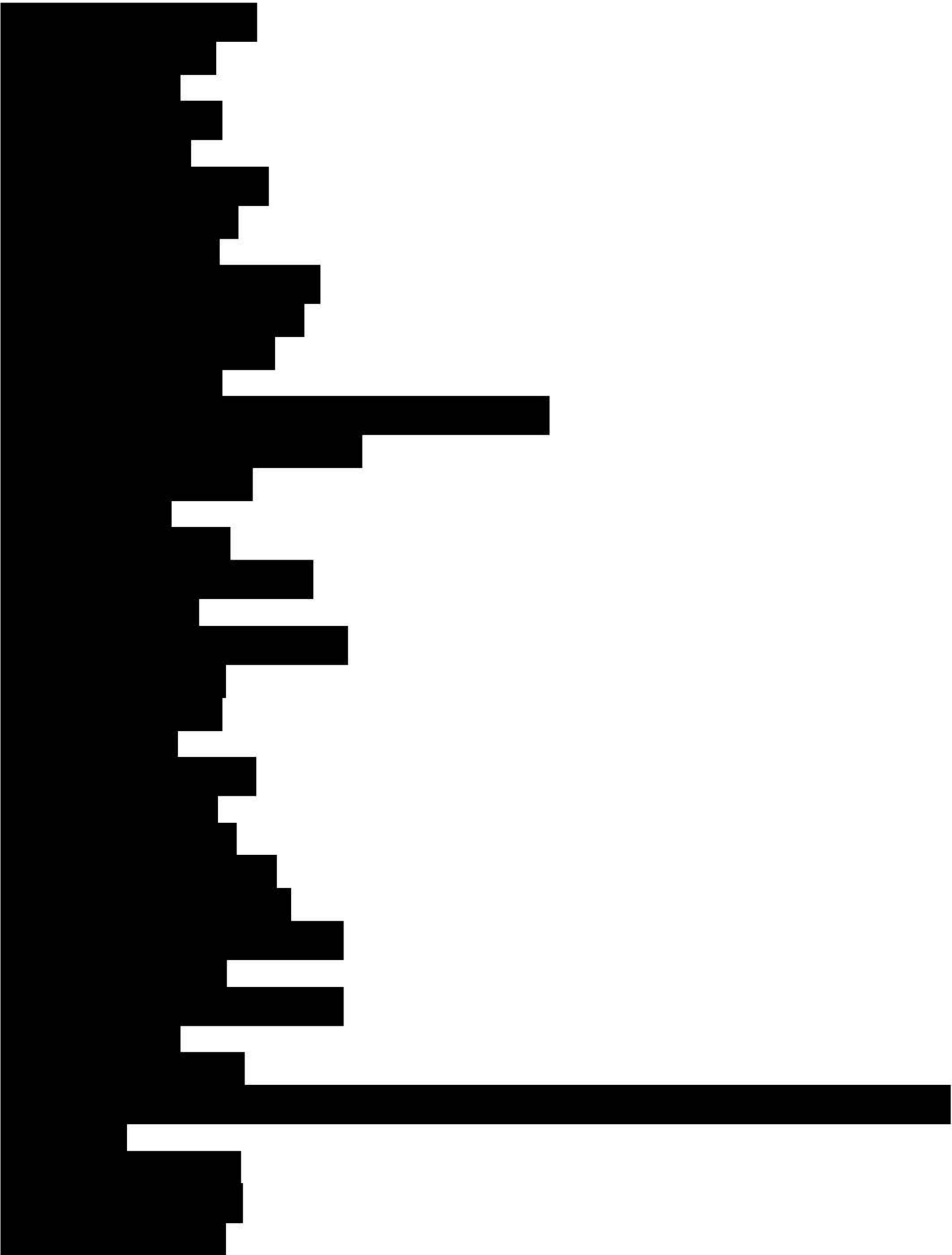
I strongly object to the mandating or coercion to inflict any medical procedures (vaccines) in any circumstances.

In 1991 only 71% of children aged 0-6 were vaccinated against whooping cough.
We had 347 cases of whooping cough.

In 2011 95% of children aged 0-5 were vaccinated against whooping cough.
We had 38,571 cases of whooping cough.

Mandating medical procedures is contrary to human rights.

UNESCO

Universal Declaration of Bioethics and Human Rights

19 October 2005

Article 6 – Consent

1. Any preventive, diagnostic and therapeutic medical intervention is only to be carried out with the prior, free and informed consent of the person concerned, based on adequate information. The consent should, where appropriate, be express and may be withdrawn by the person concerned at any time and for any reason without disadvantage or prejudice.

Article 11 – Non-discrimination and non-stigmatization

No individual or group should be discriminated against or stigmatized on any grounds, in violation of human dignity, human rights and fundamental freedoms.
