If not too late I would like to add my experience of vaccination to my email of 15th July.

When our first child received his first and second DPT injections at 3 and 5 months the reactions were unexpected as I was not told of possible side effects. He nearly died and it has been the most traumatic time of my life. It has since been diagnosed as encephalitis -brain swelling that emergency room medics label and the law prosecutes as Shaken Baby Syndrome. Polysorbate 80, an ingredient in about 15 vaccines has been a possible cause and is known to cause anaphylactic shock.

With years of investigation I have learnt that the vaccine industry does not care for our health and influences the media so that unless a parent sees a reaction in their own child or other families, they go with the flow and don't investigate this potentially dangerous medical practice.
