We write to indicate our support for ensuring that sexually explicit outdoor advertising in the State of Queensland is not allowed on roadside bill boards, shopfront windows, on public shelters and public transport and any other outdoor area where viewing by children can take place.

Even for us as adults, this type of material seen in many public places is highly distasteful, offensive and a further sad indictment of the loss of moral substance in our society.
