Health Legislation Amendment Bill 2014 - Submissions

We refer to your email dated 12 September 2014 regarding the Health Legislation Amendment Bill 2014.

We would like to offer the following submissions with respect to the Bill:

1. Clauses 19 to 39 (amendments to the Hospital and Health Boards Act 2011)

Clause 27 - We question whether Section 103(1)(b)(i) should in fact refer to section 102(2)(b) not 102(3)(b)?

Clause 29(4) – We question whether Section 106(7) (line 16) should also in fact refer to section 102(2)(b) not 102(3)(b)?

Clause 31(1) – We suggest that Section 102(2) is correct and should not be replaced with 102(3) in line with comments at Clause 27 and Clause 29(4).

Clause 32 – We would also suggest deleting the word 'by' at Section 116(3) and inserting '; or' at the end of Section 116(3)(c).

Clause 36 – There are no new provisions which would allow a Health Service Chief Executive (HSCE) to authorise an external service provider in line with the new Part 7, division 3 (section 161A) or confirming the application of the

Information Privacy Act 2009 (section 161B). We would request similar provisions in favour of a HSCE.

2. Clauses 52 to 67 (amendments to the Tobacco and Other Smoking Products Act 1998)

These amendments will significantly impact the Townsville Hospital and Health Service (HHS) since the HHS includes a Sub-Acute Facility as well as two Aged Care Facilities.

The HHS will be liable to manage a significant number of patients and elderly residents who will need to move off the health facility to have a cigarette. This has significant staffing implications in that the HHS will become liable to escort these residents/patients off the health facility and also exposes these residents/patients and the escorting staff, to an increased risk of falls and further harm.
