Hello. My name is Jennifer Conomos. I live in Brisbane and I am a retired School Teacher. We need to show respect and reverence for human life. Babies surviving abortion have as much right to medical care as babies born normally. Protection of the most vulnerable among us is the most fundamental responsibility of our Government. The Queensland Health Dept. regulations do not have the authority of laws passed by Parliament. If this Bill is not passed by Parliament, then the Qld. Govt.'s ability to help an aborted child is greatly diminished and is far weaker than it is in some other States. (eg. Victoria and N.S.W.) I strongly urge the committee to recommend that the QLD Parliament pass this legislation.
