If the government fails to pass this legislation to approve babies born alive after an abortion being treated the same as any other babies, Queensland Health may change its decision to do so. That would result in medical staff literally abandoning the child by willful neglect, which in my opinion would be abhorrent.

I strongly recommend that the Parliament pass this legislation to protect the rights of all children born alive.
