Babies born alive are humans, therefore are enabled to the same human rights as every other human. As above. These babies are alive, and are therefore fully enabled to the same human rights as any baby born alive to a parent not seeking an abortion. Protecting all human life is a fundamental responsibility of government. Failing to protect the right to life of aborted baby born alive is a violation of human rights and sets up a system whereby certain humans are considered less enabled to fundamental rights than others.
