Hello, my name is [REDACTED], I am retired and during my life have been involved in Childbirth education. I also, [REDACTED], husband of [REDACTED], share the following beliefs and concerns.
In a country where birth numbers are already falling, it is sad that women feel it necessary to pursue abortions, but to know that numbers of babies are born alive during the process, yet "put aside" and denied care to sustain their lives, is abhorrent.
