My name is [REDACTED], and am retired after spending over 40 years in emergency services minimising the impact of adverse events on individuals, and in some instances even saving lives at some risk to my own. All human life is sacred, despite the notion held by some that a life outside the womb is somehow more precious than one within. A baby born alive after a failed abortion then, is a clear example of precious life now outside the womb.  
A society is judged by how it treats its most vulnerable people, and leaving helpless infant humans to die is a scourge on our state, and more broadly our nation.
