**Submitter Comments:**

IT IS OUR WILL that ALL "emergency powers" be abolished immediately and that the current emergency powers not be extended beyond the current date of 31 October 2022. IT IS OUR WILL that ALL emergency powers be stripped entirely of the Chief Health Officer who is NOT a representative of the people but an Officer of the State, and is unaccountable to the people of Queensland and has absolutely no authority empowered by the people of Queensland to enact any orders or emergency powers which will affect the people of Queensland's lives. The fact that these new Emergency Health Bill will override the people of Queensland's democratic rights, human rights and our Common Law is deplorable, undemocratic, draconian and against all Common Law rights of the common man.
