**Subject:** Submission Public Health and Other Legislation (Extension of Expiring Provisions) Amendment Bill 2020

Greetings.

I note that during many parts of this process your Queensland Parliaments officers were instructed to make physical contact with individuals who were not at that time under arrest and were not suspected of any crime. There were also individuals forced to endure home detention sentences in the manner of convicted criminals.

As a First Nation person I do not accept your parliaments obvious breaches of the common law against these people as legitimate and consider your parliaments actions criminal. Your group are subjects of a foreign power and we do not accept your English Crown as having ownership or authority on this land. This is First nation land, always has been and always will be.

Your group is free to make any form of public health suggestion you see fit and you are encouraged to make facilities and processes available to any consenting public but any action taken against nonconsenting individuals will continue to be considered criminal assault as it has always been.
