Dear Committee Secretary,

I refer to your email of 4 December 2020 regarding the Public Health and Other Legislation (Extension of Expiring Provisions) Amendment Bill 2020.

We note that the Bill extends the expiry dates of the amendments made to the Mental Health Act 2016 (MHA2016) through the Justice and Other Legislation (COVID-19 Emergency Response) Amendment Act 2020 to allow:

- declarations to be made about a mental health service through an expedited process; and
- mental health patients to be granted leave to comply with public health directions for a further six months until the end of September 2021.

While the Commission appreciates the implications of the ongoing pandemic for the MHA2016, we encourage consultation with people with a lived experience of mental ill-health who are strongly impacted by these changes.
