How are the health department going to act on these laws ie: manpower to enforce the new laws. Coloured packs of cigarettes are being sold at present which im sure they will take steps to package these in plain packaging to make them look like they are legit. Will the health department have trained inspectors? These illicit stores are very easy to pick as they have plain signage and don't come under the major banner ie: cignal, TSG Smokemart.

When these new laws are passed are these inspectors going to be visiting these types of stores as they are not at the present.

How will these stores be stopped as at the minute they might be raided and within hours they reopen doing the same thing. time and time again.

Will these new laws mean that the police can confiscate any amount of chop chop.
