To all Queensland MP's

I SUPPORT the passing of the Voluntary Assisted Dying Bill.

I saw the suffering my mother endured prior to her death from bowel cancer. She preferred to die rather than prolong her suffering, despite palliative care. I (and most people I know) would have greater peace of mind if there was a legal option to CHOOSE to terminate my life and die with dignity if I were suffering intolerably.

If I allowed my dog to suffer for a prolonged period until he eventually dies 12 months later, I would be charged with cruelty. So why should people be different and forced to endure this cruelty.

It is my understanding that the vast majority of people SUPPORT Voluntary Assisted Dying. Members of Parliament are elected to represent the people. Therefore I beg that all MP's support this Bill.
