Subject: Opposition to Clauses of "Voluntary Assisted Dying" Bill

I express my strong objection to Clauses of the Bill which has been tabled in Queensland Parliament.

I particularly stand against the idea that "Medical Practitioners", who have sworn an oath at Graduation to "Cause no Harm", and who object to Euthanasia, could, if they counsel against it, face up to 7 years in Jail.

Two close family members are practising Medical Practitioners in Rural Queensland. The backlash against an authority that robbed their communities of Medical service for such a period would be staggering.

Provision should be ensured that assessments be performed by experienced, additionally trained, mature Medical Practitioners with substantial knowledge of their patients.

I am 78 years old, have a disability (chondrosarcoma, right femur) and feel threatened by this Bill.
