He was fine one day and then we were told by nursing staff that he had lost consciousness and we need to make funeral arrangements. We were shocked as he had a previous checkup the week before and was told that he had still along time to live. We are now of the opinion that the doctors [REDACTED] He died within the next 36 hours. We are now convinced that the doctors practiced euthanasia without our permission. In my professional capacity of a pastor who is often been present with family members has their love ones have passed away... I have since seen the same pattern occur in Qld hospitals on numerous occasions. I urgently request that you not proceed with this bill.
