I strongly oppose this Bill and believe it is a very dangerous Bill which would lead to unnecessary deaths in Queensland.

These unnecessary deaths would come about for the following reasons:

1. People who wrongfully access assisted suicide because of wrong diagnosis/prognosis, coercion, elder abuse, untreated mental anguish, or because they had little or no access to palliative care specialists and consequently feel they have no other choice but to kill themselves.
2. There are also grave concerns, that like Victoria, there would be an increase in non-assisted suicide rates because of a suicide contagion effect that often accompanies euthanasia or assisted suicide being legalised.
