I've experienced an 100yr old and 3mths woman whose breath had ceased and very faint heart beat revive after prayer. Her death twelve hours later gave time for reconciliation with her daughter and peace with her son-in-law. Death can be difficult, painful and terrible to go through but so is the agony of the time prior to a planned assisted death as it often causes division, stress, confusion and rejection. Please, instead, invest in high level palliative care for all dying people of any age or financial situation.
