I own and operate a small guided fishing tour business in Cairns and over the last 10 years of working on the water in my local creeks rivers and estuaries i have noticed a significant increase in the number of crocodiles seen in the wild. Although i haven't had any aggressive or inquisitive alterations yet, i am worried that it is only a matter of time till such an incident may occur (just recently in the NT a crocodile did leap to grab an occupant out of a boat, luckily the person survived but it is still frightening that could happen). Without some sort of measure controlling the increasing numbers of crocodiles in Queensland there will be a detrimental effect on not only my business directly but also tourism as a whole (I've already had clients concerned enquires about the potential risk of crocodiles).
