i live in a regional town an hour from brisbane, and not remote. i am passionate about ensuring recyclables make their way to the right place rather than landfill.i believe we have good options for returning the containers for the 10c refunds. however a very major flaw in the system is that many local governments have a number of years ago removed many if not most recycling bins from public places. those are all going to landfill, as that's the only option unless people are keen to take them away with them.
