I am a property owner for a home in Dysart. I am unable to reside in it myself, and am in the position where I have to have a tenant in place.

The financial situation is that I purchased the property for K305 a few years ago. The closure of Norwich mine has radically reduced the value of the house, and I would be lucky to sell it for K100, but as I still owe K280, I am being forced to subsidise the mortgage repayments of approx \$1800 per month, plus rates, insurance etc.

I am a 65 year old pensioner, and this is causing extreme financial pressure and stress which I do not need in my twilight years. Reemploying locals, possibly at a lower rate of pay, instead of FIFO workers would bring the town back to life and ease this stress. I AM SURE YOU DO NOT WANT DYSART TO BECOME A GHOST TOWN.
