I note that Abbott Point is included in those ports named to fall under the proposed legislation.

It is a better plan for exporters of coal or other fossil fuels to use an existing port already in operation, and thereby <u>not even start</u> necessary work to be done at Abbott Point, <u>if it</u> <u>was indeed meant to be added to the list of Queensland coastal ports.</u>

Road and rail infrastructure which could service mines in this region needs to connect with existing ports such as Townsville and Gladstone.
