We are writing in support of the above Bill, introduced by Rob Katter, MP, on the 16th of September. Our concern is in relation to the recent rise of "Uber" taxi drivers in Queensland, and their potential impact. An illegal taxi service, existing alongside services covered by existing Laws weakens the way people perceive current laws. If it continues, it will see qualified taxi drivers loosing work, but worse, it will be only a matter of time before someone is either kidnapped, raped or murdered by a professed "Uber" driver. How does one consider a driver to be a "Safe" driver, not just in relation to their driving history, but in relation to their fellow citizens?
