Rules & Regulations are put in place to achieve social, political, environmental and economic outcomes that would not be otherwise achieved within an open marketplace.


Regulations are necessary when competition within a market has the potential to exploit and bring harm to society. Consequently, regulations are intended to benefit consumers and drive a healthier business environment.
