I request the Government take into consideration our New Zealand friends who live and work in Australia or visit Australia be treated as Queenslanders and are allowed to apply and are granted a firearms license under the same conditions as Queenslanders are, to hunt& shoot in competitions in Queensland. Also I would like to suggest we be allowed sound moderation for firearms, to enable shooters to engage ferals without notifying all animals within a 10 kilometre radius and also without alarming residents within hearing range from the landowner next door that is doing pest control and not causing harm to anyone else. I would also request the Government NOT limit firearms owners to how many firearms can be owned by an individual as there are a vast range of firearms needed to control ferals but are not suited to shooting sports and collectors of historic firearms can acquire many dozens of firearms that in all probability are not usable to shoot or no ammunition is available for them. Firearms owners should only need a PTA for their first firearm as that is the "cooling off period" required as was required by law as posted in 1996. We don't need a "cooling off period " if we already have a firearm. Please look at crimes committed with firearms, penalties need to be severe for these offenses.
