It attacks the root cause of the terrible terror attack that occurred at Bondi while not punishing those such as myself who has been and continues to demonstrate themselves as a law abiding firearms owner. I hope this legislation being put through opens up further inquiries into firearms such as suppressors being removed from category R and made available to the public. Contrary to their portrayal in media and by uneducated anti-gun groups they do not silence weapons; they only reduce the decibel to a safer level for those firing firearms, and those around them. I know at my local gun range we are restricted to loading one round at a time to comply with noise restrictions as a residential suburb has been built next door. Enabling shooters to access suppressors would be beneficial to the whole public community around the range, not just the shooter in this instance.
