I'm a law-abiding firearms owner and I support this Bill as it's currently written.

It targets the real problem — keeping guns out of the hands of criminals and extremists — while still allowing responsible shooters to continue legal sport, work, and recreational use. The exemptions for non-citizens involved in approved shooting clubs or genuine occupational roles are practical and reflect how the real shooting community operates.

I also support that existing licences are not being cancelled and that there is a reasonable transition period for storage changes. Responsible shooters understand the need for safe storage and clear rules, as long as they remain fair and workable.

Please keep the Bill in its current balanced form and avoid adding extra restrictions that would only impact lawful and compliant firearms owners.
