I thank the Queensland government in realising that Qld shooters were not responsible for the Bondi killings of innocent Australians. I believe that as the laws stand now, we have one of the strictest laws covering the use of longarms but there is a couple of amendments, some may be noticeable. It should be only Australians who are able to get a weapons license, and not some immigrant who has only been here a short time. The government intelligence agencies & police must work together to check all submissions fully if a non Australian wants to apply for a license under special circumstances, and if the whole family are non Australians their background must also be checked as well.

I support NO CAPS on the amount of weapons held by Australians as there are different calibres requirements for different animals to be taken & different setups of firearms for day shooting as is with night shooting of feral animals. The no cap limit also would cover some shooters who are collectors of fine longarms and some who buy extra weapons as family & friends may be invited to hunt ferals but don't have the needs to get their own weapons or those who buy their own weapons but let the family member hold it under their names.
