I write to you regarding my submission to the Amendment Bill 2012. My wife & I own a commercial lot in the Amity Body Corporate CTS 17543, within the Dockside precinct at Kangaroo Point in Brisbane. In 2006,a district court ruling,ordered the lot entitlement contributions be adjusted to make the entitlements between the commercial & residential lots more eveny divided.

With changes to the legislation in April last year, it allowed the court ruling to be overturned with a motion put forward by ONE lot owner & in doing so, our annual body corporate fees increase from \$7,114.86 to \$20,670.15, not including the insurance levy or early payment discount.

As there are 9 commercial lots, 2 carpark lots & 42 residential lots it is NOT JUST, REASONABLE OR EQUITABLE for the commercial lots to be paying nearly 43% of the budget.

As a result of this flawed legislation, we will suffer great financial difficulty in paying the increased fees & also maintaining ownership of the property.

I therefore request the committee to take all this into consideration & approve the proposals put forward by the Honourable Jarrod Bleijie.
