As the Owner/Occupier of a unit in the Q1 Building, we were confronted during the year with a more than 50% increase in Body Corporate fees.

We are retired and on a "fixed" income, although the value has been drastically reduced due to the GFC and increases in the cost of living.

Body Corporate fees pay for the maintenance and care of the common property areas of the building, an expense which should be equally carried by unit owners, unless there are some costs which are not equal (e.g. window cleaning). These are already taken into consideration when the Body Corporate fees were made equal.

We support fully the bill introduced on 14 September 2012 by the Attorney General.
