Please retain the current requirement for voters to provide proof of identity, in the form of the voter's personal card (provided by the Electoral office) before casting their vote. This card should be handed in to the Electoral Officer, who then crosses off the voter's name.

This is a requirement widely accepted by the community, and is needed to ensure the integrity of our Electoral system through preventing voter fraud.

When the voter has to hand over his card, it prevents him from going to yet another booth and trying to vote there as well. By using his card, and handing it in, it ensures he gets only one vote.
