Dear Director,
I know that it is my duty to keep you informed of MY WILL on anything that comes before Parliament, or that should come before Parliament.

IT IS MY WILL to make known my **STRONG OPPOSITION** to the 'Electoral and Other Legislation Amendment Bill 2015' (as introduced by Yvette D'Ath MP).

My reasons relating to the key points are:-

**** Reinstate the \$1,000 gift threshold amount, backdated to 21 November 2013.***

This will achieve nothing other than to provide the ALP with the means to continue receiving unaccounted for funding/services as provided by both Union support and other so called tax free organisations its members have been involved with creating. This will effectively hinder other political parties in their efforts for funding. **IT IS MY WILL** to oppose this point.

**** Remove voter proof of identity requirement.***
