We are writing this submission to support the 31 recommendations implementing the Belcarra legislation. But would like also to see bans from corporate and businesses as well.

The policy objective of the Local Government Electoral (Implementing Belcarra) and Other Legislation Amendment Bill 2017 is to implement certain recommendations of the Crime and Corruption Commission's (CCC) report *Operation Belcarra: A blueprint for integrity and addressing corruption risk in local government* (the Belcarra report) to:

1. Reinforce integrity and minimise corruption risk that political donations from property developers has potential to cause at both a state and local government level
2. Improve transparency and accountability in state and local government
3. Strengthen the legislative requirements that regulate how a councillor must deal with a real or perceived conflict of interest or a material personal interest.


