

protesters are using any sort of dangerous or booby-trap style approaches? It makes no sense to me that they would, given that the greatest strength of their protest movement is that they are specifically non-violent.

Such legislation smells of political framing of a legitimate protest movement and has no credibility or need.

I would therefore ask that members reject this dangerous and unnecessary Bill immediately.
