Re: *Police Powers and Responsibilities and Other Legislation Amendment Bill* 2019

Thank you for consulting with the Queensland Police Union ("QPU") in relation to the above Bill. As you would be aware the QPU represents over 12,500 police officers, watchhouse officers, liaison officers and band members throughout Queensland.

The QPU supports Government implementing the legislative tools our members require to safely and efficiently serve the people of Queensland and to prevent crime.

The Bill proposes to address access to digital information powers. The existing powers are extremely useful when investigating serious crimes such as paedophilia, terrorism and sexual offences such as rapes. Unfortunately, with advances in technology and the increasing use of widely available encryption, criminals have become more sophisticated in their attempts to avoid apprehension.

The proposed new powers contained in the Bill go a long way to ensuring Queensland's police can remain a step ahead and provide them with the tools necessary to effectively police with today's technology.

The QPU commends the Bill to the Committee and expresses its support for the above provisions.

In terms of the remaining provisions, the QPU notes there are amendments to assist Weapons Licencing Branch and also to improve the efficiency of the Prostitution Licencing Authority. The QPU also is generally supportive of those amendments.
