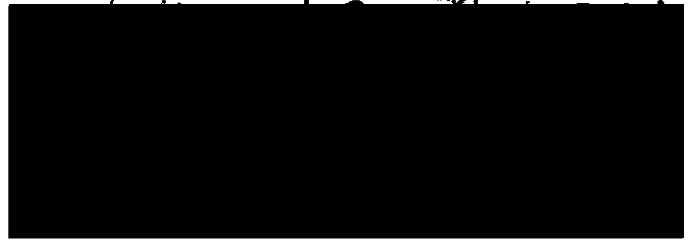

Re: Amendments to the Anti Discrimination Act.
unfairly against Sex Workers.

Dear Sir / Madam,

I would like to voice my Strong
Objection to the Charges / Amendments to the
Anti Discrimination Act (1991) that would now
make it legal for Motel Owners to Refuse
Accommodation to legal Sole trader Sex Workers
for the following reasons.

- ① It is Discriminatory to Single out Sex Workers
businesses and disallow them to run their discreet
business from their Motel Accommodation because
other Business people run their Businesses out of
Motel rooms when they are travelling, so why
shouldn't a Sex Worker be able to discreetly do so.
- ② I am concerned about Sex Workers Safety
if they are ejected or Exposed as a Sex Worker
to the other Motel guests and people in the

Community who could Target them for harassment, intimidation, Bribery, extortion, threats against a Sex workers Safety ^{person} if She or he doesn't comply. Or the Sex Worker could be RUN OUT OF TOWN, HUMILIATED, PUBLICALLY EXPOSED TO VIGILANTEES.

(3) I am concerned that Sex Workers will be targeted by the Police and will face unfair and unjust charges against them as they are being evicted, or if a disgruntled Motel Operator or member of the Community or guest of Motel calls up the Police and tells them there is a Sex Worker staying next door to them, or in their Motel rooms - Mysteria will prevail and a Sex Workers Safety, Human Rights, Privacy, and dignity will be compromised.

(4) I am concerned that some Motel Owners will charge Sex Workers Double or Triple Prices to stay at their Motels and if they don't comply then the Motel Owner will deny them Accommodation. These charges to the Act will bring on Extortion and Bribery and Exploitation of Sex Workers by unscrupulous Motel Owners.

⑤ These changes to the Act will open up the door to Persecution of Sex Workers and Human Rights abuses against them as well as other Discrimination against Sex Workers in other areas. eg. Landlords and Real Estate Agents will start denying or EVICTING Sex Workers out of their Private Residences

⑥ Sex Workers will be falsely accused of Soliciting outside their Motel Rooms as they walk to and from their Cars. Or around the town - And the Qld Parliament have not given these OUTRAGEOUS Amendments enough time in Consultation Process.

⑦ Sex Workers Clients and their Privacy will be INVADED, By Police bursting in or knocking on ~~the~~ motel room doors after a Motel Owner reports the Sex Worker to the Police.

⑧ These changes to the Act ARE DISCRIMINATORY and Persecute Sex Workers and their Businesses and UNLAWFUL MASTERIA WILL FOLLOW.
