Re: Criminal and Other Legislation Amendment Bill 2011 Your Ref: 11.1.6.C

Thank you for the opportunity to forward a submission on some of the proposed amendments.

My submission includes comments in relation to;

- 1. Liquor Act 1992 and
- 2. Retirement Villages Act 1999
- 1. Liquor Act 1992
  - a. The exemption should be extended to include Residents Committees and Residents Associations of Retirement Villages. The current exemption is unclear.
  - 2. Retirement Villages Act 1999
    - a. Ensure that the chief executive retain the <u>option</u> to refuse registration if it is inconsistent with the objectives of the Act.
    - b. CPI percentage increase should include clarification of the;
      - application of CPI test to prior year <u>budgets</u> rather than <u>costs</u>
      - general services rather than line items on a budget
      - and the exemption of Maintenance Reserve, carried forward surpluses or deficiencies and \$107 items.





- c. Clarification of the 'Termination Date' should include consideration of the date the vacated unit becomes available to refurbish.
- d. Reinstatement costs paid from Capital Replacement Fund. The clarification should be limited to only including that these costs 'must' be paid from CRF 'whenever' an operator pays for retirement costs.
- e. Payment of charges for a vacated unit should only be amended to clarify that 'the right to reside' terminates once the unit becomes available for refurbishment.

I am happy to provide further details to each of these points at a later date. Time prevents the inclusion of further detail in this document.
