Falsifying public documents is in no-one's interest. Not now, and not in the future - imagine researching your ancestry to trace the rare genetic disease, only to find an ancestor had 2 mothers and you can't tell which was the male. Falsifying sex data leads to inaccurate population statistics, an important part of equalities monitoring, and social planning. In many cases it is important to be able to determine who is male to exclude them from female only spaces, or to give them appropriate health care. Self-Id allows abusive (but not trans) men, to pretend a trans identity to humiliate and abuse women and children. No.
