There should not be specific age on wearing of the locator band as courts will confirm many of repeat crimes are happening well prior to the age of 16-17 # All criminal history and especially repeat offences while on bail should be considered prior to bail being granted # Home invasion of any kind should be classed as a very serious offence and the home owner is innocent for using reasonable force to protect his family and property especially if the offence occurs during the night # A financial guarantee (based on previous criminal history) should be imposed upon those (courts, parents and guardians) that accept that BAIL is an acceptable risk of the offender not reoffending while on bail. This money should be then used to pay restitution for damage caused while on bail.

Curfew should be imposed upon children at risk under the age of 14 who are out after midnight and 6 am and not in the company of a parent or guardian.

Child safety and those agencies associated with children at risk should have 24hr access for police to be able to bring these at risk individuals to so as the proper care can be implemented.
