Onboarding clunky and slow to finalise memberships, lack of consultation with 1<sup>st</sup> officers and brigade when problems arise, nil support from RFSQ staff.

Result== New members leave before membership is granted.

Retention Under the new QFD and RFSQ training for new and long standing members has become almost non available.

Lack of available trainers due to the sacking of volunteer trainers (RFSOs) and staff role changes (Brigade training and support officer now Brigade support officer) Brigades have no way of training FMS – FAS- Crew leader.

Due to the banking system with certain restrictions in place and bad management by senior staff many brigade treasurers are ready to resign.

Overall lack of respect and support shown to volunteers by staff will result in the decline of Rural Fire volunteers and closure of many brigades.
