Anna's Treason

Anna Bligh, our illustrious Queensland Premier, has commissioned the Legal, Constitutional and Administrative Review Committee of the Queensland Parliament to 1. draft a preamble for the Queensland Constitution; and 2. develop options for modernising the oaths and affirmations in the Queensland Constitution. This is the oath that Anna Bligh herself was forced to take before she could take her place on the parliamentary benches as it is indeed her 'duty statement.' I don't suppose she meant a word of it and only took it to gain her share of parliamentary privilege. Now she wants us to join with her in her complete disregard of her oath. "Your Throne is the Lord's Throne. Beware of making His Throne a Throne of iniquity." "But as the Throne is the Lord's Throne, let the laws be the Lord's Laws, agreeable to His Word." "Lastly, if your Throne be the Throne of the Lord, take a word of encouragement against Throne adversaries. Your enemies are the enemies of the Lord's Throne."

Mrs Bligh, in her characteristic, brutal and dictatorial way, under the self confessed dictates of undisclosed entities is now attempting to emasculate the oaths to make herself the fount of all authority instead of God. Is this the manifestation of the Augustus syndrome?

The gathering of people's submissions to assist in this endeavour is but a sop. A mere theatre meant for the public consumption of those who are informed and for those who are uninformed, an exercise in futility.
