

VIEWS -- LAW, JUSTICE AND SAFETY COMMITTEE A NEW LOCAL GOVERNMENT ELECTORAL ACT: REVIEW OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ELECTORAL SYSTEM

I hereby submit the following submission as an individual (elected Councillor of the Cassowary Coast Regional Council) representing Division 4.

Our Local Government area is currently divided into six (6) Divisions and two and a half years into this term, following the March 2008 Election, the forced amalgamation of former Cardwell and Johnstone Shires remains a huge obstacle to our future planning and progress and Divisions only foster this situation.
