WE WISH TO MAKE SOME  
SUBMISSIONS TO "THE LEGAL CONSTITUT

2/ THESE PERSONS SHOULD NOT HAVE  
TO SHOW "GENUINE REASON" TO OWN FIREARMS  
OR POSSESS FIREARMS. THE RELATIVE  
AUTHORITIES SHOULD HAVE TO PROVE WHY  
A PERSON CANNOT POSSESS OR OWN FIREARMS

3/ THESE PERSONS SHOULD HAVE THE  
RIGHT TO POSSESS OR OWN A FIREARM TO  
PROTECT SELF & FAMILY IN A SITUATION  
WHICH THEY CONSIDER TO BE OF A REAL

DANGER TO THEM WILL BEING

4/ THESE PERSONS SHOULD HAVE THE RIGHT TO OWN, ACQUIRE AND DISPOSE OF THEIR FIREARMS AT THEIR DISCRETION TO LIKE PERSONS, WITHOUT INTERFERENCE FROM THE GOVERNMENT OR ANY GOVERNMENT BODIES.

5/ THESE PERSONS SHOULD BE RESPONSIBLY FOR THE STORAGE AND SAFE KEEPING OF THEIR FIREARMS IN THEIR OWN HOMES WITHOUT GOVERNMENT INTERFERENCE.

6/ THESE PERSONS WHO WISH TO COLLECT FIREARMS AND PRESERVE HERITAGE ITEMS SHOULD HAVE THE RIGHT TO OWN, STORE AT THEIR HOMES AND DISPLAY THEM TO THE POPULATION OF AUSTRALIA WITHOUT UNDOE INTERFERENCE FROM THE GOVERNMENT OR GOVERNMENT BODIES.
