TO SHOW "GENUINE REASON" TO OWN FIREARMS
OR POSSESS FIREARMS. THE RELATIVE
AUTHORIES SHOULD HAVE TO PROVE WHY
A PERSON CANNOT POSSES OR OWN FIREARMS

3/ THESE PERSONS SHOULD HAVE THE
RIGHT TO POSSESS OR OWN A FIREARM TO
PROTECT SELF & FAMILY IN A SITUATION
WHICH THEY CONSIDER TO BE OF A REAL

DANGER TO THEIR WELL BEING

4/ THESE PERSONS SHOULD HAVE
THE RIGHT TO OWN, ACQUIRE AND
DISPOSE OF THEIR FIREARMS AT THEIR
DISCRETION TO LIKE PERSONS, WITHOUT
INTERFERENCE FROM THE GOVERNMENT OR
ANY GOVERNMENT BODIES.

5/ THESE PERSONS SHOULD BE
RESPONSIBLE FOR THE STORAGE AND SAFE
KEEPING OF THEIR FIREARMS IN THEIR
OWN HOMES WITHOUT GOVERNMENT
INTERFERENCE.

6/ THESE PERSONS WHO WISH TO COLLECT
FIREARMS AND PRESERVE HERITAGE ITEMS
SHOULD HAVE THE RIGHT TO OWN, STORE
AT THEIR HOMES AND DISPLAY THEM TO THE
POPULATION OF AUSTRALIA WITHOUT UNDUE
INTERFERENCE FROM THE GOVERNMENT OR
GOVERNMENT BODIES.
