DEAR SIR,

WITH REFERENCE TO A POSSIBLE "QLD. BILL OF RIGHTS" :-

ALL CITIZENS SHOULD HAVE THE RIGHT TO OWN ANY NORMAL FIREARM (WITH THE POSSIBLE EXCEPTION OF FULL AUTOS & ACTIVE HEAVY ARMS) WITHOUT ANY RESTRICTION FROM GOVERNMENT. THIS IS NECESSARY FOR THE DEFENCE OF OUR NATION, OURSELVES, NEIGHBOURS & PROPERTY.

I UNDERSTOOD THAT WE INHERITED THESE RIGHTS THROUGH INSTRUMENTS SUCH AS MAGNA CARTA, OUR CONSTITUTION, & POSSIBLY OTHERS.

IF THERE IS ANY DOUBT THAT WE HAVE THESE RIGHTS, THAT DOUBT SHOULD BE REMOVED FORTHWITH.

FURTHER, IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF GOVERNMENT TO PROTECT ITS CITIZENS BY REMOVING THE ABOVE RIGHT FROM ANY PERSON WHO IS A ~~PRO~~ PROVEN SERIOUS FELLOW, ANY PERSON OF UNSOUND MIND, OR ANY PERSON CONVICTED OF A SERIOUS FIREARMS OFFENCE, I.E. MURDER, ARMED ROBBERY, ETC. THIS PROCESS OF PROHIBITION MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ACCESSIBLE (NO COST) APPEAL FACILITY THROUGH AN INDEPENDANT (NON GOVERNMENT) ARBITRATOR, PUTTING THE RESPONSIBILITY

OF PROOF UPON THE GOVERNMENT.

ANY PERSON CONVICTED OF A SERIOUS
FIREARMS OFFENCE eg. MURDER, ARMED ROBBERY, etc
SHOULD BE GIVEN AN APPROPRIATE JAIL SENTENCE
WITHOUT PAROLE.
