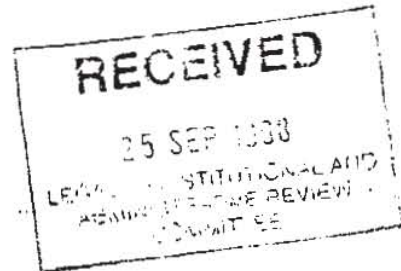

Consolidation of the Queensland Constitution

Thank you for your letter dated 10 August 1998 in which you forwarded to me the Report of the Legal, Constitutional and Administrative Review Committee in relation to consolidation of the Queensland Constitution.

You have invited a response to the Committee's Report before reporting to Parliament.

I note that the recommendations of the Committee largely relate to consolidation of the existing laws relating to Queensland's Constitution and, as such, the Committee's recommendations do not concern the Queensland Department of Main Roads to any greater extent than any other Government department.

The effect of the consolidation will be to make Queensland's constitutional laws easier to understand, and accordingly the Queensland Department of Main Roads supports the recommendations of the Report.
