



On **14 June 2009**, SQL and TASC sent out 35,000 flyers to Toowoomba residences objecting to extended trading hours and set up a website www.sqlaw.com.au.

On **25 June 2009** we lodged objections with the Liquor Licensing Office and held a great public meeting.

In July 2009 Kerry Shine MP personally delivered over 1,500 objections from our flyers to Premier Anna Bligh.

On **4 August 2009** the Bligh Government set up a parliamentary committee to investigate opening hours and alcohol related violence in Queensland.

On **16 September 2009** Anna Bligh announced a 12 month moratorium on hotel applications to allow the committee time to investigate.

SQL & TASC will be lodging a submission but we also want YOU to tell your story to the Committee.
